Key Information in the event of your child being identified as a close contact

- You will be contacted through SEESAW, FACEBOOK and the school website.
- Please see sample letter to be issued in the event of close contact with a positive case.
- We have to close the affected classroom in order to facilitate a deep clean by the Education Authoritythis may take up to 2 days or more.
- Your child will be issued with a home learning pack and learning will be facilitated through SEESAW.
- Week beginning the 6th of September all children will be issued with a "Password Passport."
- Please book a PCR and a day 8 PCR Test immediately. Children must self -isolate until the result is available.
- You can book a test at <u>www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test</u> or by phoning 119. When you are booking the PCR test online, under the section 'why are you asking for a test', please select 'I have been told by contact tracers to get a test.' When asked for a code, please enter<u>1036042J</u>
- If the result is negative then you must provide evidence of a negative result. Please send to <u>bmcveigh625@c2kni.net</u>. Children testing negative can return to school.
- If the PCR test is positive your child must self-isolate for 10 days from the date of the test
