Summary findings from ETI Inspection November 2018

- ✓ The leadership and management set out a clear vision and high expectations for promoting respectful behaviours, improving children's attainment and supporting them to overcome potential barriers to learning.
- ✓ The governors use their wide range of different yet complementary skills and
 experience to support and challenge the school to meet the needs of the children
 and celebrate their achievements.
- ✓ The school development planning process is underpinned by extensive consultation with staff, children, parents and governors and the information is used effectively in conjunction with an analysis of the school's qualitative and quantitative data to inform current priorities. The documentation indicates a whole-school approach to school improvement and an emphasis on continuous professional development for all staff.
- ✓ The processes for self-evaluation are supported by a broad range of evidence and there are clear systems in place for monitoring and evaluating the progress being made by the children.
- ✓ The extensive range of partnerships with other schools and external agencies link appropriately to the school's priorities of supporting the pastoral needs of the children and families and raising standards.

✓ During the inspection, the school provided evidence that the arrangements for safeguarding children reflect broadly the guidance from the Department of








Mission Statement
